4 **Short Term Trends Definition:** This is a seasonally adjusted comparison of the most recent 4 weeks compared with the previous 4 weeks. The marker (*) has been applied where the most recent week's performance is exceptional. A key to the symbols used are as follows:

No change
Downward trend
Upward trend

5 **Long Term Trends Definition:** This measure is calculated by taking the performance over the rolling current year, including the current month, and comparing that to the average of the same period over the last three years, expressed as a percentage change.

The long term trend calculations use the previous 24 months for DV and the previous 12 months for knife used to injure and gun crime
