The following figures refer to Sanctioned Detections for Hate Crimes comparing 2 time periods before and after the introduction of Statutory Charging.

November 03 – September 04 **11916 Offences**

November 04 – September 05 **13471 Offences**

That equates to an **8.8% INCREASE** in Sanctioned Detections since Statutory Charging.
