



Referrals: Deaths in MPS area 2004-9




- 76 deaths in custody or following police contact:
 - ⇒ 26 independent
 - ⇒ 22 managed
 - ⇒5 supervised
 - ⇒ 19 referred back / local
- 26 independent investigations:
 - ⇒8 fatal shootings
 - ⇒ 1 road traffic collision
 - ⇒ 12 deaths in or following custody
 - ⇒5 deaths following police contact




MPS Referrals 2004/2009






MPS Referrals vs. GMP & W.Mids 2008/09








Means by which allegations were completed 2008/09 (MPS)

- 6 referrals

 - √ 3 against non recording (1 upheld, 1 not upheld, 1 pending)
 - √ 1 against investigation (pending)



Thousands of people with mental health problems are being detained in police cells rather than being taken to hospital for assessment, a report says.

Over a year, more than 11,500 people were held in police custody for assessment under the Mental Health Act - double the number taken to hospital. The Independent Police Complaints Commission collated data for all 43 police forces in England and

IPCC commissioner Ian Bynoe said the situation was "intolerable".



Guardianship: Stock Take



System focussed on blame, not on resolving complaint

Encourage local handling

Streamline appeals to IPCC, greater oversight role, more meaningful data

Remove unnecessary bureaucracy
