Definitions

All classified and unclassified crime reports

- Street crime allegations consist of codes DI (Robbery of person) and DG (Snatch Theft)
- Allegations do not represent confirmed crimes. Official crime figures are published monthly via the PIB.

Safer streets boroughs

Lambeth, Westminster, Southwark, Hackney, Haringey, Camden, Tower Hamlets, Brent, Islington, Newham, Ealing, Waltham Forest, Lewsham, Wandsworth, Croydon.

Precictions

Predictions are based on a polynomial trend of historical street crime allegations, and take into account any seasonality. They provide an indication of the direction street crime allegations would be expected to follow over the forthcoming weeks.

Executive Summmary

All figures relate to street crime allegations only, and comparisons are with the same period last year.

MPS Increase of 10.5% Safer streets boroughs Increase of 11.2%


- Of the safer streets boroughs, the largest decrease was in Lewisham (-19.3%), and the largest increase was in Waltham Forest (+70.5%)

- Of the safer streets boroughs, the largest decrease was in Lambeth (-16.1%), and the largest increase was in Waltham Forest (+59.6%)




