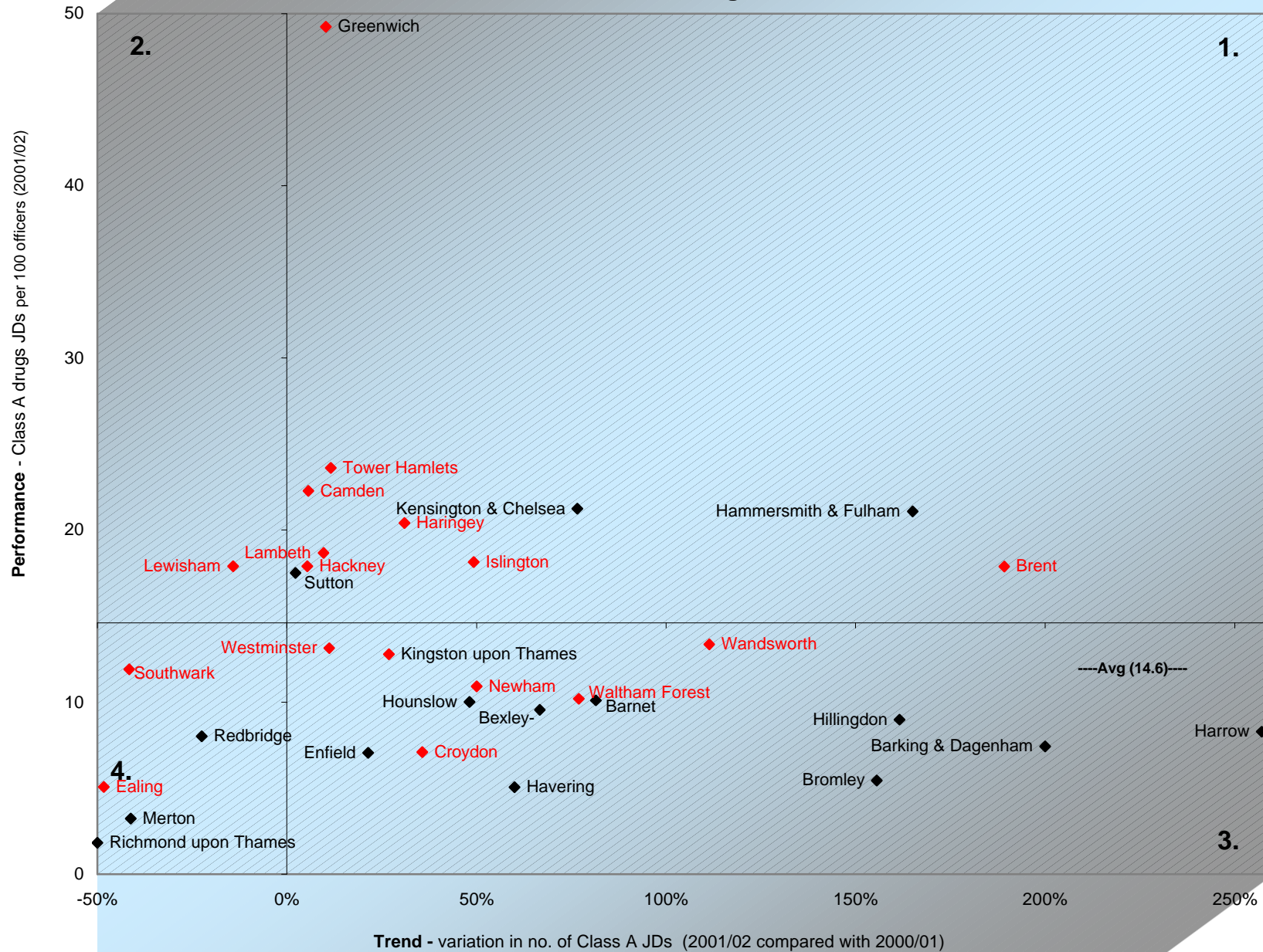
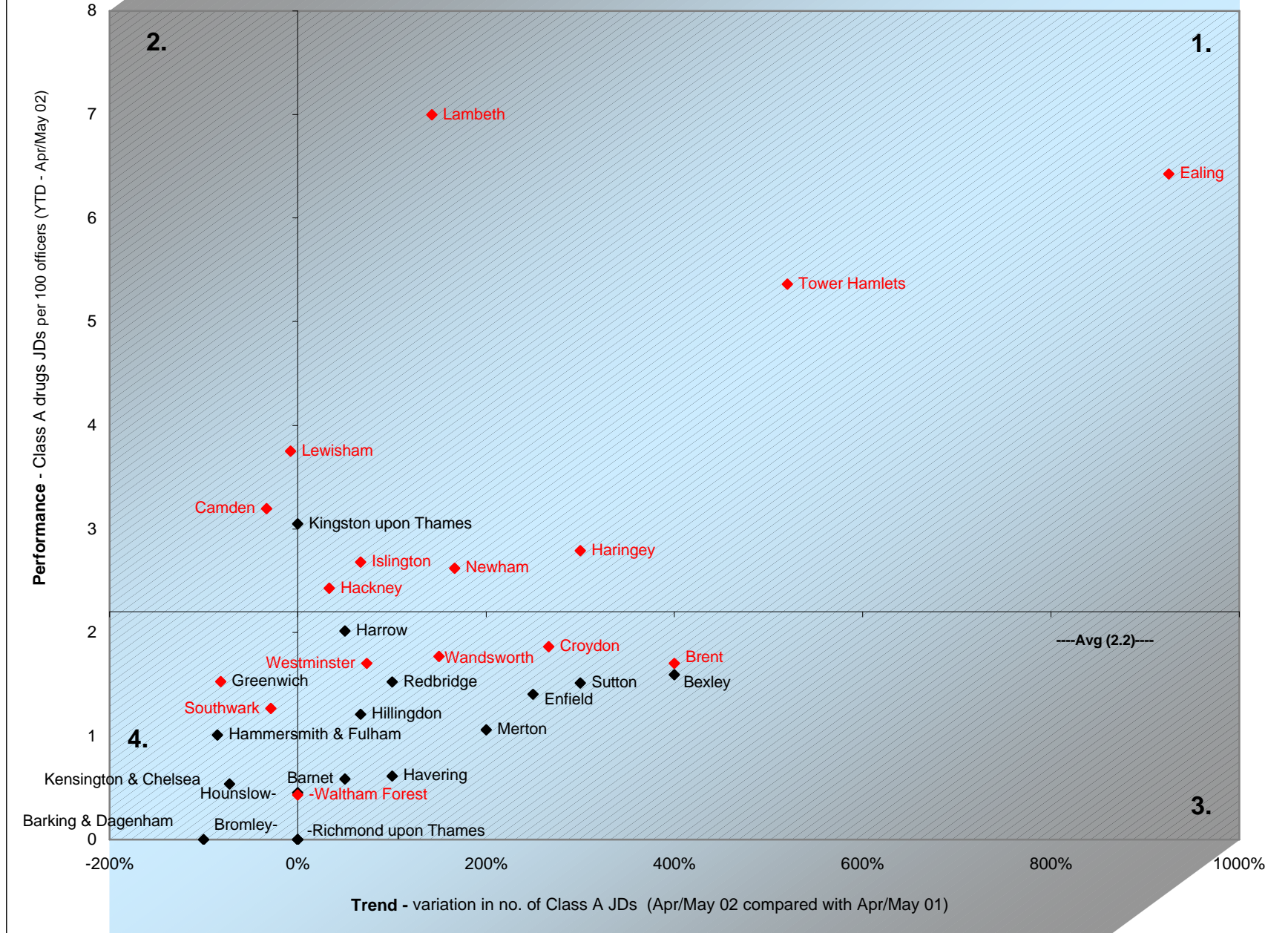


## Drugs - Class A Judicial Disposals 2001/02 Planning Year

## Interpretation Of The Boston Box

<b>KEY</b>	
<b>2.</b> <b>Above-average</b> <b>performance but in</b> <b>decline</b>	<b>1.</b> <b>Above-average</b> <b>performance and</b> <b>improving</b>
<b>4.</b> <b>Below-average</b> <b>performance and</b> <b>declining</b>	<b>3.</b> <b>Below-average</b> <b>performance but</b> <b>improving</b>

The vertical axis shows **performance** during the 2001/02 planning year (1) or Apr/May 2002 (2). This is shown as % JDs per 100 officers. Average MPS performance is used to position the horizontal axis and those boroughs performing better than the MPS average are shown in either section 1. or 2. (ie above the horizontal axis).

The horizontal axis (**trend**) shows how last year compared with the year before (ie % increase/reduction in number of JDs in 2001/02 compared with 2000/01). Those boroughs whose performance has improved in the last year are shown in either section 1. or 3. (ie to the right of the vertical axis.)
