# Specialist Operations MPA High Level Indicators

### Performance report for the period April to May 2003

#### Introduction

There are changes to the format of this report in comparison to that submitted for the January 2003 meeting. This is the result of the split between Specialist Operations (SO) and Specialist Crime Directorate (SCD) and the differing reporting strategies now in force. The main differences in the SO report is the change to monthly data, in order to better fit in with the intended reporting schedule, and a slight alteration in presentation style.

Three of the High Level Performance Indicators included in this report differ from 2002/03 in line with the recent planning process.

#### These are:

**SO16** Emergency requests for mobile response to Diplomatic missions/residences & central government premises/ministerial residences within 6 minutes now 85% of the time (from 90%).

**SO17** Monthly seizures at Strangers' Gallery now not to exceed 5% (from 10%) of total seized on the Palace of Westminster Estate.

**SO12** Percentage of urgent and high priority actions responded to within target time is no longer included. The low number of actions recorded reducing their value as an indicator of SO12 performance.

It is anticipated that future reports will be submitted in this format pending a review of Management Information within SO later this year.

In the light of heightened security measures, because of the continued high threat status of terrorist attack, this continues to be a busy time for SO, with increased operational commitments supporting not only counter terrorism but also Borough and SCD initiatives.

# Specialist Operations Comments

### 1

#### **Counter Terrorism (SO13)**

SO13

For the planning year 2003/04 to date SO13 have maintained their strong performance from 2002/03, hitting or exceeding targets on three of their High Level Indicators. However, answering the terrorist 'Hotline' within the set time slipped in May due to a high number of nuisance calls received from a known individual whose number is familiar to the telephone operators and is therefore treated as a lower priority than would otherwise be the case.

#### 2 Ro

#### Royalty Protection, Diplomatic Protection & Palace of Westminster

SO16 Diplomatic Protection G

A vastly increased work load (eight fold over the same period - April / May 2003 - 772 vs April / May 2002 - 100) in the use of Diplomatic Protection Group Mobile Units to support Boroughs highlighted a difficulty in distinguishing between BOCU 12 minute response time calls and SO16 6 minute response time calls. Early indications show a below par performance for the higher SO16 standard in this area (response times for the rest of the MPS are, generally, 75% within 12 minutes). Systems are being developed to differentiate between the different call out types.

There is 100% provision of armed security to Palace of Westminster and Ceremonial & State events. These tend to fall in June (Trooping the Colour & Beating the Retreat) and November (Festival of Remembrance, Remembrance Sunday, State Opening of Parliament & Allied Jewish Ex-Servicemen Parade).

SO16 are currently undertaking extra counter terrorism patrols and supporting Boroughs through the use of Diplomatic Protection Group mobile units.

#### SO17

Palace Of Westminster

SO17 fall slightly below target responding to personal attack and intruder alarm activations. Of the 5 not responded to within 3 minutes so far this year: 4 were intruder alarms - which were all dealt with within 6 minutes - and the other a personal attack (PAB) alarm - dealt with in just over 6 minutes. All 5 were in remote locations, activated by faults or work conducted by contractors. SO17 examine all the circumstances surrounding such activations with the aim of implementing the lessons learnt.

No weapons have so far this year been seized at Strangers' Gallery.

## Policy Support

SO19 Force Firearms Unit

The Directed Patrol Target of 61% became effective from April 2003. In April SO19 achieved 56% and in May the figure achieved was 53%. The number of Armed Response Vehicle (ARV) calls has been steadily increasing with a significant increase in May with these calls being in more geographically diverse areas other than just on the Hotspot Boroughs. Consequently the ARV's assigned to Directed Patrol Boroughs have had to travel to these calls and thus have been away from their Directed Patrol Areas. In order to counteract this problem, two additional ARV's have been geographically deployed to the East and West of the MPS Area. This will enable the Directed Patrol ARV's to spend more time on their designated areas and thus achieve the set targets. This situation will be closely monitored and appropriate action taken to address any shortfalls.

#### SOID

Heathrow

Heathrow has no recorded terrorist incidents since March 1994 and continues to adopt the appropriate security measures to combat any perceived threat.

## **Special Branch**

SO12

SO12 has maintained its strong performance exceeding both its remaining High Level Indicators. A Year To Date figure has not been included for Operations against Priority Targets, this is to reduce double counting as operations may overlap two or more months; last years figure related to March 2003 only.
